PURPOSE:

- Promote attitudes and behaviour which contribute to personal and community well being.
- Develop in students the ability to make decisions about personal and community health matters and to encourage students to take responsibility for such decisions.
- Provide accurate information about health and health-related matters.
- Develop a critical approach towards personal and social factors which influence the quality of life enjoyed by all individuals or communities.

GUIDELINES:

- The program will cover all of topics included in the Victorian Curriculum.
- Continue to develop knowledge and skills about Health related issues through integrated programs.

IMPLEMENTATION:

- The following documents will form the basis of the program: Victorian Curriculum and Health Scope & Sequence document.
- The Health Coordinator along with Level Teams are responsible for the integration of health topics into their teaching and learning.
- Family Life organisation to cover the puberty/sexuality standards in Victorian Curriculum Levels 5&6. They will cover these standards in two lessons for both Level 5 and 6 students.
- Level teams to incorporate Health focuses/standards into at least one integrated unit per year.
