PURPOSE

- To encourage students to be responsible for their own safety and the safety of others when travelling.
- To teach students decision-making and technical skills required to increase safety.
- To develop an attitude that predisposes students towards taking greater care when travelling.
- To enable students to responsibly apply knowledge and skills.

GUIDELINES

The program will incorporate all year levels.

- traffic/pedestrian Safety (Foundation to Level 6)
- bike education (Levels 4 and 5)

The program will be sequential and continuous so that all students are engaged in some learning in this area.

Students will be offered practical activities that develop their skills of bicycle use and traffic management at Levels 4 and 5.

IMPLEMENTATION

The Victorian Curriculum - Personal, Social and Community Health strand of the Health and Physical Education learning area - will underpin the planning and implementation of the program.

ASSESSMENT

Students taking part in Bike Education will be assessed.

Other traffic/pedestrian safety education areas will be assessed by classroom teachers.
